Membership Secretary's report 2016-17

This year we have transferred to our new database and website with the option for members to select from three membership types:

- Full membership
- Student / Retired / Unwaged membership
- Mailing list only membership

Current membership numbers across the three categories are:

Full membership	244
Student / Retired / Unwaged membership	85
Mailing list only membership	287

The total paid membership number of 329 represents a drop on previous years:

Membership Numbers

This drop is predominantly due to moving all members who previously had Standing Orders at the older lower membership rate to "Mailing List Only". We anticipate numbers will rise again. The number of concessionary members (student, retired or unwaged) has risen from 68 in 2015-16 to 85 in 2016-17.
