Submissions have reduced since last year, which is likely to be due to the problems with the weather for the Nottingham conference, and the reduced engagement with the Wales conference. It was encouraging to see a large proportion of New Researchers submitting papers, but some of these required considerable support and three papers were not subsequently resubmitted as the researchers did not have time to address the issues (despite the deadline being substantially extended). There was a smaller proportion of presenters from the Wales Day Conference who submitted for proceedings than I would have expected. Formatting was improved although referencing is still an issue.
