Treasurer's Report 2017-18

The BSRLM's current balance is £36,264.22. The balance has been dropping over the last few years which is largely as a result of the development and maintenance of the website, but this has meant we are now dipping into our savings. We have discussed what to do with the surplus over the last few years but we would like to hold off making any decision about this until the website is functioning in such a way that it takes over some of the manual and time-consuming tasks that members of the execommittee are currently undertaking.

Since the closure of the Nat West account in 2015-16 and the decision to move anyone paying previous membership rates to the 'mailing list only' category, we have received only a small number of new members who have chosen to pay via Standing Order. The advantage to the Society of members paying by Standing Order is that we don't have to pay fees (PayPal charge us £1.39 for each full membership and 88p for each RSU membership) and subscriptions are automatically paid into our account each year. The membership of members paying by Standing Order therefore tends to be more stable. However, converting these payments into memberships is a manual and time-consuming task required of the treasurer. Although there are fees to pay when memberships are bought through PayPal, there is no system to automatically renew memberships so the onus is on the member to remember to renew, which is typically just before they book the next conference. The advantage to this approach is that the website switches the membership status immediately, requiring no manual input from the exec members. We are still hoping that in further website developments, we will be able to make this process more automated, requiring less time of the executive committee members.

The current balance of the Leone Burton Fund is £2,724.16. This fund is used to support New Researchers attending the NRD conference, to stay overnight (up to £40) to join the next day's main conference. There was a donation to this fund in 2014-15 which boosted the fund, but unfortunately, we have lost the facility to encourage members to contribute to this fund through the website development and thus there were no donations this year. The web team are looking into how this can be re-incorporated into the conference booking process. There were no claims made for this fund this

year for the New Researchers at the Swansea conference. Although this was advertised, the Welsh government funded several membership and conference fees for some of the teachers who attended the conference this year so they did not take advantage of this fund.

The Janet Duffin account was set up by Janet's family and is used to refund expenses for the author of the winning RME journal article, when they come to give a talk at one of the Society's conferences. The current balance is £2067.94 but Janet's family are keen to continue with this fund and they will be topping up this fund this year.

The cost of running conferences has fluctuated in the last few years. The London conferences in 2016 were expensive but since then we have been fortunate to secure some venues which have not charged the Society for rooms. The following table provides a 'price per head' cost of each conference over the last three years.
