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Treasurer's Report 2018-19

The BSRLM's current overall balance is £28,788.17. This figure has been reducing over the last few years. For the current year the just under £7500 difference from the 2017-18 total is accounted for largely by two outlays. Firstly, BSRLM commissioned a review of its informal proceedings from 2003-2017 and paid an honorarium of £4000 to a University of Brighton team who undertook this work. Secondly following considerable discussion regarding ways to address difficulties with the functioning of the website, the executive team has asked the current web developers to rebuild the site. This is currently underway; we have so far spent £3600 on this development with a further £1500 anticipated on completion of the work. A transfer of £8000 was made from the savings account in order to fund these two specific costs.

Aside from this website redevelopment, regular maintenance and some additional security updates result in a total expenditure on the website of £6753.70 for this year, close on double that of last year. The new website should ensure greater ease of use for members and exec team members alike and reduce some of the manual tasks that exec team members currently undertake.

Annual membership fees remain at £35 standard and £20 student/retired/unwaged. Approximately 180 members pay by a repeating standing order, the majority pay through Paypal on an annual basis. For those paying through Paypal a charge is levied on each transaction, but the advantage of this payment method is that membership status is updated automatically. For those paying by standing order the treasurer manually changes membership status on the website. The current web development should automate this process for all payment methods and offer a renewal reminder for current members. Membership income is lower this year than for the previous two years; many Paypal membership renewals are made just prior to conference attendance. This means that our membership levels are closely tied to our conference programme; strong conference attendance will render our membership base and resulting income secure.

Conference fee income this year matched that of the previous year, but both these two recent years have seen a reduction from 2016-17 and 2015-16 income. Conference costs continue to fluctuate depending on catering costs at different institutions and on whether we are able to use seminar rooms without charge. We have been fortunate this year to have been charged catering fees only at two of our locations. The cost per attendee of conferences over the three most recent years is shown below. For the current year conference expenditure is particularly low because we are awaiting an invoice from a recent conference.

This fund is used to support New Researchers attending the NRD conference to stay overnight (up to £40) and join the next day's main conference. There was one donation to this fund during the 2018-19 year. Three claims were made on the Leone Burton fund for New Researchers at the Birmingham conference in June. This follows more explicit advertising of the fund by our day conference organisers.

The Janet Duffin account was set up by Janet's family and is used to refund expenses for the author of the winning RME journal article, when they come to give a talk at one of the Society's conferences. The current balance is £1746.34. Janet's family are keen to continue with this fund and they will be topping up this fund.
