1. Spring conference University of Cambridge

The Spring 2020 conference in Cambridge went ahead despite growing concerns about the Covid-19 pandemic.

Feedback from the conference was overwhelmingly positive with comments relating to many good aspects including overall organization, the venue, the quality of the presentations and the food. The shift to 40-minute sessions was well-received by the vast majority who commented.

2. Summer Conference and New Researchers' Day 2020

The face to face conferences scheduled to take place in June were cancelled due to Covid-19.

A virtual New Researchers' Day took place on 9th July 2020.

Technology:

- Teams (UoN) was used
- Invitations and joining instructions were sent out to people who had registered to attend
- An opportunity to try out the technology was provided on the evening prior to the conference
- Three breakout rooms and a general room were provided
- Sessions were 40 minutes
- Lessons learned include requiring institutional email addresses for those who use Teams in their institutions

Programme:

- Two keynotes, one at the start (Geoff Wake) and one at the end (Jennie Golding)
- Three pre-lunch parallel sessions (9 in all) were programmed. One did not happen as the presenter was not there (didn't register!).
- Three post-lunch parallel sessions (9 in all) were programmed. One did not happen as the presenter could not connect.
- Members of the exec chaired sets of three parallel sessions. This worked well.
- 43 registered participants.
