Proposal 1

Proposal: Change the start of the constitution from the current wording:

<Name 1. The Society has the name "The British Society for Research into Learning Mathematics" (BSRLM)>

To the following:

<Name and status 1. The Society has the name "The British Society for Research into Learning Mathematics" (BSRLM). BSRLM is an unincorporated association.>

Proposal 2

Context: We would like to establish a solidarity fund for mathematics education researchers in the UK who have been displaced. Proposal

Proposal: We propose that BSRLM establishes a solidarity fund, to be advertised on our website. The fund will offer 2 years free membership and free attendance at online conferences. The following criteria will be used:

having UK Asylum status or Discretionary/Limited Leave to Remain as a result of an Asylum application, and those with Humanitarian Protection (as a result of an asylum application) and a letter of recommendation from a BSRLM member

Unanimously approved.
