In several cases, authors were asked to undertake minor or major revisions to address formatting issues and to clarify aspects of their work.

- The write-up rate for the March 2026 conference was 66%, representing a substantial increase on previous conferences and indicating a positive and encouraging trend.

valuable to observe the diversity of perspectives and the range of exploratory and innovative work being undertaken by BSRLM members.
